

Stool Collection Instructions

1. Collect the stool and place inside the specimen container.

STOOL MUST NOT TOUCH THE TOILET WATER OR ANY URINE *Containers May Vary*

- 2. Using the tongue depressors given, transfer some stool from the specimen container into all vials given. Each vial that has liquid should be filled to the indicated line/arrow, each Sterile cup given should be filled at least half way.
- 3. You will have 24 hours to bring in the specimen once it is collected, if the stool is going overnight, the STERILE containers must be Refrigerated/Frozen ONLY, the next morning you can transfer the stool to the smaller vials, the vials <u>CANNOT</u> go refrigerated or go overnight with stool. (Very important), once in the smaller vials you will have 3 hrs to drop it off at the lab.
- 4. Please DO NOT discard any of the containers, unless otherwise indicated.
